Language & Literacy (English & Mandarin)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Listening and Speaking: Songs, rhymes, stories, and conversations to build vocabulary and language skills.• Emerging Literacy: Letter recognition, common words, and storytelling with picture books.• Basic Writing: Tracing, drawing shapes, and early letter formation with crayons and finger paints.
Early Math Concepts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Number Recognition: Counting and recognizing numbers 1–10 through songs and games.• Shapes & Patterns: Identifying shapes, sorting, and recognizing patterns.• Measurement & Sorting: Comparing sizes and sorting by color or size.
Creative Arts	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Visual Arts: Drawing, coloring, and crafting to boost creativity and fine motor skills.• Music & Movement: Singing, rhythm, instruments, and dancing to enhance listening and motor skills.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Gross Motor: Running, jumping, balancing, and playing to build coordination.• Fine Motor: Puzzles, threading, and small object play to improve hand-eye coordination.
Social-Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sharing & Cooperation: Group activities for turn-taking and polite interaction.• Self-Regulation: Managing emotions and following rules.• Independence: Encouraging self-help skills like putting on shoes and cleaning up.
